Pregnancy and Breast Feeding

As with all medicines you should consult your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicine if pregnant or breast feeding.

Driving or Operating Machinery

This medicine normally works without causing dizziness or drowsiness, but care should be taken initially as rare exceptions can occur. If affected do not drive or operate machinery.

Ingredients Guidance

This product contains 3.07g sucrose per 5ml dose. This should be taken into account in patients with diabetes. If you have been told by your doctor that you have an intolerance to some sugars, contact your doctor before taking this medicine. Also contains small amounts of ethanol (alcohol), less than 100mg per 10ml dose.

IF YOU ACCIDENTALLY TAKE TOO MUCH see a doctor straight away.

Do not use after the expiry date shown on the label.

Side Effects

Side effects do not happen very often with this medicine, however, on rare occasions some people may experience: constipation, stomach pains, dizziness, drowsiness, nausea and vomiting. If you notice any of these side effects or any not mentioned, stop taking the product and tell your doctor or pharmacist.

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Full Ingredients List

Dextromethorphan hydrobromide, menthol, anise oil, capsicum tincture (capsicum oleoresin, ethanol), caramel (E150), macrogol cetostearyl ether, cineole, chloroform, citric acid monohydrate (E330), diethyl ether, glycerol, peppermint oil, purified water and syrup.

Action

This medicine contains dextromethorphan hydrobromide which reduces the desire to cough in people with troublesome unproductive coughs. Menthol also acts to relieve irritation, reduces congestion and helps you breathe more easily.

Precautions

Do not use if: • you know you are sensitive to any of the ingredients listed, or if you already have general breathing difficulties • you have a liver complaint • you are taking, or have taken, antidepressants (monoamine oxidase inhibitors - MAOIs) within the past two weeks • you are having an asthma attack • your cough is productive (with phlegm) or you have had it for a considerable time (see your pharmacist).

Ask your doctor or pharmacist before use if:

- you are taking cimetidine or any other medicines
- you have a history of asthma.
