Intended use

This cheek swab kit is designed for adults (aged 18 and over) for the collection of a DNA sample to be performed at home, which is then used for laboratory analysis for a variety of tests that involve genetic material. This kit alone is not suitable for screening or diagnosis and is not a substitute for a consultation with a healthcare professional.

You should always seek advice from your doctor before starting any treatment.

Getting your DNA test results

When your sample has been processed, you'll receive an email to say your results are ready. This is usually within **7-10 days** of your sample arriving at our laboratory.

To view your results and download your report, log in to your account at **www.myhealthchecked.com** and click on the test in question.

Important notes for swabbing before you start

Collection Monday-Thursday

You must collect your sample in the morning between Monday and Thursday and post it on the same day.

This ensures your sample is not delayed in the post which will impact the stability of your sample and our ability to provide you with test results.

Do not collect your swab sample or place it in the post on a weekend or bank holiday as there will be postal delays.



Food or drink

Traces of food or drink (including tea and coffee) might impair the quality and purity of your sample. Collect your DNA sample at least 1 hour after eating or drinking.



Avoid mouthwash

The use of mouthwash or toothpaste prior to sample collection can also impair your DNA quantity. Please avoid using any non-foodstuffs or ally (including brushing your teeth) for 1 hour prior to sample collection.



Rinse mouth

For best results, rinse your mouth with water immediately prior to sampling.


Please ensure you have read and understood the instructions for use before collecting your sample.

Activate your swab

When you are ready to collect your sample, it's essential that you activate your swab using your unique barcode number. This should be done immediately prior to sample collection, and is done online at www.myhealthchecked.com/activate-kit. We can't process your sample if it hasn't been activated.

Collecting your cheek swab sample

Open the outer packet





Remove the swab

Carefully remove the swab and the inner RapiDri™ pouch from the outer packet, taking care not to touch the white swab head with your fingers.

Discard the outer packet and small label

The outer packet can now be discarded, along with the small barcode label inside the outer packet – this is not required.

6 Rinse mouth

Rinse mouth with water immediately prior to sampling.

6 Collect sample

Insert the swab into your mouth and rub firmly against the inside of your cheek or underneath lower or upper lips. Rub for 1 minute, using reasonable, firm and solid pressure.



Put the swab into the pouch

Carefully place the swab headfirst back into the inner RapiDri™ Pouch, ensuring the head sits within the area marked 'Drying Area'.



8 Seal the pouch

Fold the pouch (containing your sample) at the area marked 'Fold Line' with the clear side inwards. Then use your unique barcode label to seal the pouch closed so we can identify your sample at the lab.
