Use at the back of the throat only.</p> <p>Do not breathe in when you use the spray or get the spray in your eyes.</p> <p>To spray: swing the nozzle through 90° and press.</p> <p>Before first use or after storing the spray for a long time: press the spray 3 times away from the face into a sink.</p> <p>Adults and children of 12 years and over: 3 sprays at the back of the throat, every 3 hours if you need to.</p> <p>Don't use more than 6 times in any 24 hours.</p> <p>Do not use for children under 12 years.</p> <p>Do not use more than the amount recommended above.</p> <p>If you use too much: talk to a doctor straight away.
