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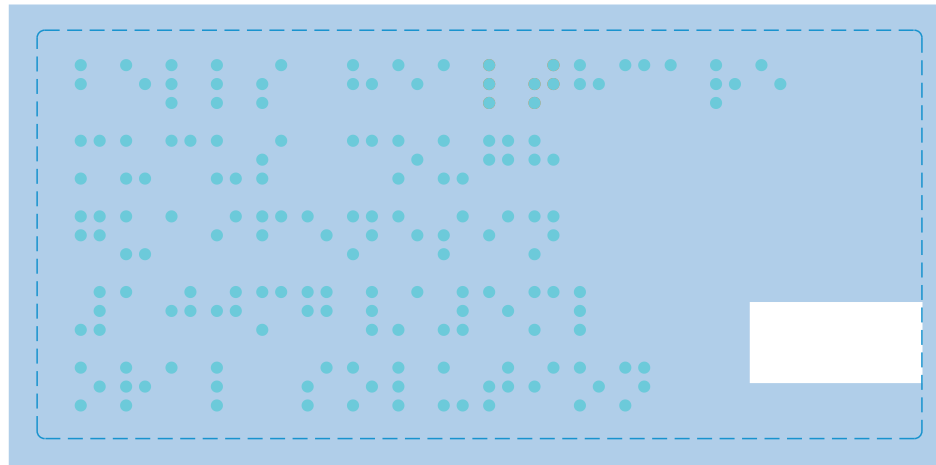

Dosage
Liquid for oral use. **Adults, the elderly and children over 12 years of age:** Take 5 to 10ml every two or three hours. Not more than 4 doses should be given in any 24 hours. **Do not take more medicine than the label tells you to.** Do not take with any other cough medicines. **Not recommended for children under 12 years.** Please wipe bottle neck after use. Stop use and ask a healthcare professional if your cough lasts for more than 5 days, comes back, or is accompanied by a fever, rash or persistent headache.

Warnings
Do not use: • If you are allergic to any of the ingredients. **Consult your doctor before use.** • If you are taking any prescribed medicines or undergoing medical tests • If you suffer from a chronic cough: • If you have asthma or are suffering from acute asthma attack: • If you have an intolerance to some sugars.
