



PACKAGE LEAFLET: INFORMATION FOR USERS

Dettol Liquid

Chloroxylenol 4.8% w/v

1. DETTOL LIQUID

Dettol Liquid is an effective concentrated antiseptic solution that kills bacteria and provides protection against the germs which can cause infection and illness. It can be used for antiseptic cleansing of minor wounds caused by cuts, bites, grazes, insect stings and for personal hygiene.

2. BEFORE YOU USE DETTOL LIQUID

- For external use only.
- Do not swallow.
- Do not use on eczema or similar skin conditions.
- Do not use if you are allergic to Chloroxylenol or any of the ingredients.
- Do not use after the expiry date printed on the bottle.
- Not recommended for use around cats.

3. HOW TO USE DETTOL LIQUID

Do not use undiluted.

FOR WOUND CLEANSING:

Wash the affected area with one large spoonful (12.5 ml) of Dettol Liquid diluted to a half pint (¼ litre) of water. Cover with dry gauze or lint.

PERSONAL HYGIENE:

Douching (when medically advised): 2 teaspoonfuls in 2 pints of warm water.

Dandruff: 1 tablespoonful to 1 pint of warm water. Pour over scalp, leave for 10 minutes before shampooing.

Spots and pimples: 1 tablespoonful in half pint of warm water.

Bathe affected area daily.

If swallowed, wash out mouth and drink plenty of water or milk.

If contact is made with the eyes, wash them thoroughly with cold water. In both cases, consult your doctor and take this bottle with you.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

If you experience any side effects after using this product, speak to your pharmacist or doctor.

Reporting of side effects:

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. You can also report side effects directly via the Yellow Card Scheme at:

5. HOW TO STORE DETTOL LIQUID

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

6. FURTHER INFORMATION

Dettol liquid contains Chloroxylenol 4.8% w/v as the active substance and also Pine oil, Isopropyl alcohol, Castor oil, Caustic soda solution, Caramel, Water.

Dettol Liquid is a clear amber liquid. Once diluted in water it becomes a milky white solution. It is available in bottles of 250mL, 500mL, 750mL, and 4L
