### **What this medicine is for**

A cooling astringent solution for the relief of discomfort of bruises, sprains, minor skin irritation, rough or sore unbroken skin.

### **Before you use this medicine**

#### **X Do not use:**

- **If you are allergic** to distilled witch hazel

**You can use** this medicine if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

#### **✓ How to use this medicine**

Check the cap seal is not broken before first use. If it is, do not use the medicine.

**Adults and children:** Soak a piece of cotton wool with the solution and gently dab the solution onto the skin. Cover the skin with a bandage. Keep the bandage moist with witch hazel.

For use on the skin only.

Do not apply to broken skin.

If symptoms do not go away talk to your doctor.

**If anyone accidentally swallows some:** Talk to a pharmacist or doctor.

### **Possible side effects**

Most people will not have problems, but some may get:

- Allergic reactions (e.g. rash, red or itchy skin)
